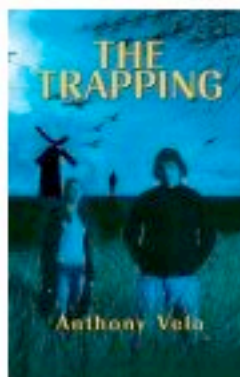


The Trapping
